



## 2026 Disney Greeting Card Challenge

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### OVERVIEW

We are excited to announce a new challenge in partnership with the Walt Disney Company! In this challenge, our focus is on expanding our Greeting Card assortment. As Minted has grown its wholesale presence in new stores like Whole Foods and H.E.B., we have secured the rights to sell **both Disney and Pixar properties** in these new retail partners. Please note:

- We are sourcing approximately 70 picks\*
- Winning designs will be sold under the Minted brand name through our retail partners, or under the Minted brand name through our subscription service.
- We have obtained rights to sell both Disney and Pixar properties through some of our new wholesale partners; we will continue to only sell Pixar properties through Target

Open for your interpretation in this challenge are characters from Disney and Pixar films as well as Pooh & Friends. Be sure to review the allowable characters list, as some new ones have been added! The team at Disney is excited to see your original artistic takes on their portfolio of beloved characters. **As a reminder: There is no critique period for Disney Challenges; please do not share or post your designs anywhere until winners are announced. Only winning submissions may be shared.**

We strongly suggest you review the challenge training deck linked below in the **How it Works** section, as it will include helpful guidelines that help illustrate what we're looking for. Above all, it is essential that your copy and concept ties back to the property represented in a way that is true to the character. **Our full approved property list is [here](#).**

- We are limiting artists to a maximum of **10 submissions per artist** for this Challenge. Please note that this submission limit is separate from our Disney Stationery & Art Challenge. *K-level Greeting Card artists in our CMYK program are exempt from this submission limit.*
- Winning designs will also be considered for repurpose opportunities into other Minted product categories.

*\*there may be significant variation in the total number of picks, depending on Disney approvals*

## HOW IT WORKS

This Disney Challenge will be different from a normal Minted Design Challenge. It is important for you to review this brief in detail before you submit any artwork. Due to required partner approvals, this process will take longer than the normal Minted Design Challenge process. Here are the steps in the Minted-Disney process:

<b>1) Mandatory Training</b>	<b>2) Private Submission</b>	<b>3) Private Voting</b>	<b>4) Disney Brand Review</b>	<b>5) File Requests</b>	<b>6) Winners Announcement</b>
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1. **Mandatory Training:** All artists who choose to participate in this Challenge must review mandatory training materials to understand how the Challenge works, the special Terms & Conditions for this Challenge, and Disney's style guidelines. **It is required to review this password-protected PDF before submitting:**

2. **Private Submissions:** One of the biggest differences in this Challenge is that the submission phase will be completely private due to contractual requirements. You will use our standard submission form, but your submission will only be visible to you. **We will not have our normal peer critique period after the Submission Period closes.**
3. **Private Voting:** Submissions will go through private voting. As always, we will ensure that every entry receives sufficient votes for us to determine which entries will move forward.
4. **Disney Brand Review:** Disney will review all submissions that pass the private voting stage. The purpose is to ensure that submissions meet their brand guidelines.
5. **File Requests:** In some cases, we might need to request files from you with design notes before we're 100% certain if your design will be launched, because we may need to submit samples as part of the approval process.

6. **Winners Announcement:** We will announce winners once they have passed Disney's final product approval. Only winning designs which have passed Disney's Brand guidelines will be published to our winners page.
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## CHARACTERS AND PROPERTIES

- **We will accept** submissions for pieces featuring or based on characters from Disney, Pixar, and Pooh & Friends.
- **We will not accept** entries for Star Wars, Marvel, Muppets, Disney Jr., 20th Century Studios, or Nightmare Before Christmas.
- Please keep in mind these character restrictions:
  - Characters from Frozen, Moana, and Cars are not allowed on Baby Shower or other designs intended for infants (e.g. 1st Birthday).
  - Princesses from different worlds should not look at each other. Official Disney Princesses include: Ariel, Aurora, Belle, Cinderella, Jasmine, Moana, Merida, Mulan, Pocahontas, Rapunzel, Raya, Snow White, Tiana

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## PRIZES

### TOP-RATED PRIZES

The Top-Rated pieces, as voted by consumers and artists, will receive the following prizes **plus an ongoing commission of 6%**:

FIRST PRIZE: **\$2,000**

SECOND PRIZE: **\$1,000**

THIRD PRIZE: **\$500**

### EDITORS' PICKS AWARDS

Minted will select additional designs for sale as Editors' Picks, with artists of selected designs receiving **\$170** in prizes, **plus ongoing commission of 6% of net sales of the products sold**. ### SPECIAL PRIZES

Among the Top-Rated pieces and Editors' Picks, Minted's Editorial Council will also award Special Prizes\* to individual pieces.

#### 1. Everyday Awards:

- a. For the best Everyday greeting card featuring any Pixar property with a clever concept. The card should work for the "Thinking of You" category, and ideally could flex into many use cases (like Adult Birthday, Love, etc.) **\$200**
- b. For the best Kid's Birthday greeting card featuring a Disney property, featuring one of the following properties: Frozen, Disney Princess, Moana, Mickey/Minnie/Mickey & Friends: **\$200**
- c. For the best Baby greeting card featuring characters from Winnie The Pooh: **\$200**
- d. For the best Everyday greeting card featuring a Disney property, in one of the following categories/properties: **\$200**
  - i. Love/Wedding/Anniversary (Mickey & Minnie)
  - ii. Everyday/Thinking of You/Blanks (Mickey & Minnie, Disney Princess, Lilo & Stitch or other strong copy/character concepts)

#### 2. All About Love Awards:

- a. For the best Valentine's Day or love-themed greeting card featuring a Pixar property: **\$200**
- b. For the best Valentine's Day or love-themed greeting card featuring a Disney property, preferentially Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse: **\$200**

#### 3. Holiday Cheer Awards:

- a. For the best Holiday Greeting Card featuring any Pixar property. Consider showing characters in winter clothes or participating in winter activities: **\$200**
- b. For the best Holiday Greeting Card featuring any Disney property, but preference given to Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, or Mickey & Friends. Consider showing characters in winter clothes or participating in winter activities. **\$200**

#### **4. Seasonal Holiday Awards:**

- a. For the best Mothers's Day, Father's Day, or Graduation card featuring any Pixar property: **\$150**
- b. For the best Mothers's Day, Father's Day, or Graduation card featuring any Disney property. As you design, think about what works in non-Disney: big/little pairs (like Mrs. Potts & Chip, Kanga & Roo, Mufasa & Simba); characters wearing grad caps (preference given to Mickey & Friends and Stitch). **\$150**

\*Special Prizes will be awarded at Minted's sole discretion.

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## **PLEASE READ: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

Disney's characters and other marks are the intellectual property of Disney. Please read the Contest Rules for more details about intellectual property. Here are a few important points to understand:

- Disney is allowing you to create designs based on their intellectual property (e.g. characters) in return for your agreement to the Contest Rules.
- *If your design wins*, you will be required to assign ownership of the complete composition to Disney. Minted will retain an exclusive license to the "Non-Disney Elements." Minted may sell and repurpose your artwork in various categories and would always pay you a royalty for our sales. Disney does not intend to use or sell your design, outside of the Minted partnership, but they cannot contractually guarantee that they wouldn't use it elsewhere and they would not pay Minted or you for any other usage, outside of the Minted partnership.
- *If your design does not win*, you may not use, publish, or share the complete composition anywhere, because it contains Disney intellectual property. The only permitted re-use is entering the design into a future Disney design challenge. Failure to comply with this policy could result in Disney taking legal action against you.
- *You will, however, retain your ownership of "non-Disney elements" of a non-winning design.* This means you could re-use those non-Disney elements elsewhere, as you see fit. To qualify as a non-Disney element, a design element cannot feature any Disney intellectual property and it cannot physically touch a Disney element. Please see the Contest Rules where we describe non-Disney elements in detail. Note: Minted stock photos may directly touch Disney elements.
- To be clear, you may submit designs that have design elements physically touching a Disney element, but if you want to retain ownership of any non-Disney elements in a non-winning design, those elements cannot physically touch a Disney element.

## **DISNEY CREATIVE GUIDELINES**

In order to ensure adherence to Disney's brand standards and the integrity of its characters, be sure to meet the following general design guidelines.

- Stay faithful to the essence of the character in terms of shape, skin color, coloring, apparel, hair and other character elements. Consult official Disney websites for style examples.
  - Ensure Disney character art is highly legible. The artwork should clearly and quickly read as Disney.
  - Be conceptually creative! It should feel unique from Disney's existing style guides.
  - Characters from different Disney properties should not appear together. Moana would never surf with Goofy.
  - Characters should not be placed in worlds outside of their natural environments or historical setting.
  - Artwork depicting Disney's theme parks will not be accepted.
  - Characters should not be depicted doing anything distinctly out of character.
  - Designs should not reference violence, drugs, alcohol, or other inappropriate behavior.
  - Focus on animated characters and not live action. Actor likeness rights are more difficult.
  - Lyrics will not be accepted.
  - We cannot guarantee that catchphrases will be accepted; also, they might require longer approval times.
  - Do not alter logos.
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## PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

When you submit to a Minted Challenge, we ask that you adhere to our policies and community standards. Below, we've listed the key requirements you should meet.

- All submissions to Minted Challenges **must be your own original work**. We take design originality and integrity very seriously at Minted. Any work you submit should be 100% of your own creation. Copying or tracing a design or artwork in full or in part is not permitted and could result in a suspension or permanent ban from Minted activity. [Please see these FAQs](#) for more information on design integrity and how to ensure your work is truly original
  - **AI-Generated Art:** Per our Terms & Conditions, Generative AI tools are only allowed for editing and file production workflows. Artists are responsible for ensuring they understand [Minted's AI policy](#) and that their work meets these requirements. See our [full AI Policy and FAQs](#) as well as our Terms & Conditions for more information.
  - Work cannot currently be for sale elsewhere and, once submitted, **[cannot be used anywhere else for 90 days after the submission deadline](#)**
  - Don't submit repurposes of your designs already for sale on Minted to this Challenge (Not sure if your design is a repurpose? [Find out here](#))
  - You may submit multiple artworks; however, do not submit multiple pieces with different colorways or minor tweaks. [Learn about iterations here](#)
  - During the [Critique Period](#), you may edit and refine your submission; however, don't upload completely new designs to replace **'placeholder'** submissions or your entry will be disqualified
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## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

When creating your submission, we ask that you meet a few creative requirements. These requirements are meant to ensure our products can be produced at the level of quality Minted is known for and that

customers can easily tailor designs to their needs. Below, we cover the format your design should be in and how you may use photos, stock art, elements, and fonts.

## FORMAT: GREETING CARDS

- We're looking for non-foil and foil designs without photos and without any customization
- Designs should be in portrait orientation only
- Your design should suit A7 (5" x 7") card dimensions, and allow for .1" bleed
- **Please only submit a design for the front and interior of your card in one colorway.** If your design wins, please see section "File Submission and Payment Information For Winning Designs" below for file submission information
- You must use the design template - including both the front and interior of the card - that is provided in our Challenge Kit. If you wish to submit a design with a blank interior, leave the "interior" section blank, but include it in your submission. **Entries that do not use the provided "front and interior" template will be disqualified**

## FOIL-PRESSED ELEMENTS

- Only non-customizable text and elements can be foil-pressed
- Our foil colors include: Gold, Rose Gold, Silver, Glittery Gold, Bronze, Ice Blue, Black, Strawberry, Red, and Green

## FONTS

- We encourage artists to use new and interesting fonts in their submissions! We look to artists to find trends and use the font that feels right for their design. There are some considerations to keep in mind when choosing fonts:
- Minted licenses all the fonts that we use for print and online. We are not able to distribute fonts, so each artist must purchase their own. Our [Minted Font List](#) tells you which typefaces we currently have this licensing for.
- There are some fonts we already know we are not able to license. **Please do not submit designs that use fonts that are on our [Cannot License list](#).** If your design does use one of these fonts and is selected, you are required to replace it with a Minted font before submitting your final files.
- Please note that free font sites usually do not offer the kind of licensing Minted needs, unless they specifically call out a SIL or open source license.

## STOCK ART

- All submissions to Minted + Disney Challenges must be entirely your own original work.
- **Licensed elements (clipart, textures, etc.) are not permitted** in this Challenge.
- The only exception is that **you may use licensed fonts with a proper commercial use license.**
- You are allowed to use any third-party digital brushes that are purchased outside of standard brushes that are included with the Procreate, Adobe Photoshop, or Microsoft Affinity software package.



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## CREATING AND SUBMITTING YOUR DESIGN

### 1. CREATE HIGH-RES ARTWORK

Create your design in Adobe Illustrator using the templates and textures in the Challenge Kit.

### 2. CREATE A LOW-RES SUBMISSION

Save a smaller version of your design to submit — under 600kb and sized at exactly 1100 pixels on the longest side (Not sure how? [See instructions here](#))

**Note:** If submitting a JPEG, it must be in RGB color mode

### 3. READ AND ACCEPT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

While submitting, you will be asked to thoroughly read and agree to the Minted Terms and Conditions for Design Submissions, which are included at the end of this document

**Note:** Terms and Conditions are updated each Challenge

### 4. SUBMIT YOUR DESIGNS

Submit your design via [the Disney Challenge submission page](#). You will be asked to log in, fill in the form, and upload your submission. Be sure to choose a unique title for your artwork, using letters and numbers only. On the submission page, check each box that applies to your design.

**Disney Submission Tip!** We have new naming conventions for Disney products that will help improve search/SEO results: including either “**Disney**” or “**Pixar**”, as well as the **name of the movie or character** (whichever is more recognizable). We suggest following this format in your submissions - we will also internally adjust all names prior to launch as needed.

### 5. CONNECT WITH THE COMMUNITY

Minted fosters a supportive community of artists to help you learn, grow professionally, and build relationships with like-minded creatives. We recommend you reach out to artists through the

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## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- Once submitted, you can [edit](#) or [remove](#) your design before the submission deadline. There is no Critique Period for Disney Challenges. The submission period will be immediately followed by the **private voting period**
- We analyze voting results to determine the Top-Rated winners. Additionally, Minted's Editorial Council reviews all submissions and voting data and considers further factors such as diversity of style, risk-taking, and gaps in the current assortment to help select [Editors' Picks](#). We share anticipated winner announcement timelines on our [Weekly Updates page](#). Winners are announced via email and on our [winners page](#)

## FILE SUBMISSION AND PAYMENT INFORMATION FOR WINNING DESIGNS

If your design is selected as a winner in this Challenge, you'll be asked to provide certain files in order to receive prize payment. So you know what to expect, we've listed the technical requirements of final files for winning designs and detailed our flexible prize payment structure below. When you submit to a Minted Challenge, we ask that you adhere to our policies and community standards.

Winners will receive a file request to submit via Dropbox or Minted's internal file upload system. Final artwork must meet the following criteria.

- Must be in Adobe Illustrator® format
- Be in CMYK mode (no RGB colors)
- [Have all typesetting editable in Illustrator®](#)

**Note:** Top-Rated winners will receive the listed Top-Rated cash prize amount for submitting the "Required" files listed below.

Final artwork submitted must match the low-res submission image as voted on by the private voting committee, except for changes specifically requested by Minted/Disney during the file request process.

**Files that deviate from the winning, Disney-approved submission will not be accepted; if not corrected, they will be removed from the winners list and will not be launched.** Exceptions may be made, in Minted's sole discretion, for good faith attempts to recreate the winning submission as exactly as possible, e.g. in case of file corruption.

Please understand that our crowdsourcing process works for a reason: it collects accurate feedback from consumers regarding exactly what they want to buy. By changing your design after it has been positively rated by customers, you (and we) risk undoing the magic that makes the design a bestseller.

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## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

You affirm that you are over 18 years of age, are fully able and competent to enter into the terms, conditions, obligations, affirmations, representations, and warranties set forth in these Terms and Conditions, and to abide by and comply with these Terms and Conditions.

You promise, represent, and warrant that each and every Design you submit to Minted (a) is your own original work, (b) is not currently being published, distributed, sold, or reproduced anywhere by any means in any medium (including in any books or magazines or on any websites), (c) does not contain any trademarks, logos, or copyrighted material other than that which has been provided to you by Minted or that you solely own, and (d) does not contain any content subject to any right of publicity or privacy or any unlicensed intellectual property belonging to any third party, and (e) you have notified us of any licensed intellectual property included in your design. You acknowledge that you will not use any content provided to you by Minted for any purpose other than to submit Designs incorporating such content to Minted in connection with this Contest.

**Use of Generative Artificial Intelligence (Generative AI) Tools.** Minted allows limited use of Generative AI tools in producing your Work. The only Generative AI tool you may use in connection with the creation or production of your Work are tools within the Adobe Suite, and text-based models such as ChatGPT. The use of any other Generative AI tool is subject to Minted's prior written approval. In general, the use of Generative AI tools (including Adobe) is only allowed for editing and file production workflow. In particular, generative AI tools may **not** be used to:

- Generate an entire photo or work of art for submission
- Generate a complete stationery design
- Generate an icon or an illustration within a broader design, composition, or pattern
- Generate an entire pattern with AI-generated elements, such as for the back of a card

In the interest of using this technology to support creative human work, approved generative AI tools **may** be used to:

- Ideate and brainstorm
- Create an art statement or generate design tags
- Create alternate colorways
- Retouch photos or works of art
- Extend the edges of photos or fine art images
- Extend or retouch Minted photo kit photos
- Turn a non-AI-generated element into a repeating pattern

You acknowledge that Minted may decline to select a Design for voting on Minted.com (our "Site") or as the winner of a cash award as part of the Contest (a "Prize") for any reason in its sole discretion.

If the Design is selected to be displayed by Minted for voting on our Site, then you grant us the right to use, upload, modify, reproduce, create derivative works of, and display the Design for the purposes of promoting Minted and this Contest on our Site and otherwise throughout the world, in Minted's sole discretion, both during the Contest and during the Trial Period (as defined below).

You may participate as a voter in this Contest but may only have one active Minted account under which you submit your votes. The purchase or barter of additional votes or encouragement of other users to vote under multiple accounts are considered improper voting practices. Minted reserves the right to audit suspicious voting practices and if you are found to be engaging in improper voting tactics, Minted may exclude improper votes from consideration, remove your entry or entries from consideration for this Contest, terminate your account for fraud in

Whether or not we select the Design for a Prize, you may not offer for sale, sell, or submit the Design or Matching Items (as defined below) to others or otherwise publish, distribute, or reproduce the Work or allow others to do so for any purpose until the date that is 90 days after the Contest's submission deadline (the "Trial Period"). After the expiration of the Trial Period, if Minted has not notified you that it has selected the Design for a Prize, then you will be free to use the Design for any purpose. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if you have been provided an Artist-specific, branded shopping area on a subdomain of the Site by Minted (a "Store"), to the extent you self-launched products incorporating the Design or Matching Items prior to submitting your Design to the Contest, subject to the terms and conditions governing your use of the Store, you may continue to sell such products via your Store during the Trial Period. If Minted selects your Design for a Prize, your Design will be subject to these Terms and Conditions, including the applicable Contest Prize Overview.

During the Trial Period, we may display the Design in connection with the use on products offered for sale to assess consumer interest, even if we have not yet selected your Design for a Prize.

You hereby license us the use of your name and identifying information and image ("Artist Name") for purposes of promoting the Design both during and after the Trial Period.
